FACE COVERINGS

From Monday 2 November, Scottish Government have stated that ALL STAFF AND SENIOR PUPILS have to wear face coverings in ALL CLASSES as well as in corridors; junior pupils only need to wear them in corridors and open spaces. We have purchased and distributed washable face masks for all pupils. Please ensure that your child has a face covering each day that they attend school and remind them to wear it.

Please ask your child to pack their pencil case to minimise the sharing of resources which can limit the spread of Covid.

As we move towards winter, the school is getting colder, please ensure that your child is wrapped up warmly, preferably layering their clothing to keep warm in class. While the heating is on, the windows and doors need to remain open to reduce the potential spread of Covid. We are continuing with our cleaning protocols at the start and end of each class as well as sanitising on entry to buildings. Working together will keep us all safe.

If your child has symptoms: a high temperature, a new and continuous cough or the loss/change to taste and smell then you should keep them at home and arrange to have a test done. Please inform the school that they are being tested and inform us of the results when they arrive. If the test is negative, the child can return to school.

If someone else in the household has symptoms and is being tested, please keep your child at home, if the result is negative, your child can return to school immediately. Please inform the school that testing is being carried out.
