The S4 Columba Group consulted the school and local community on School Uniform; the results have been used to create our new 'School Dress Code'.

The consultation results concluded that wearing school uniform enables our young people to identify with Carrick Academy; it builds their confidence when they meet their peers from other schools and people from local businesses.

All pupils at Carrick Academy are expected to follow the School Dress Code at all times throughout the session including examination periods.

School Dress Code:

Pupils should wear plain coloured:

- Shirt or blouse
- School tie.
- Dress trousers; girls can also wear skirts or pinafores.
- Cardigans or jumpers.
- Shoes. Black trainers are permitted as long as they are changed for P.E.
- School blazer or rain jacket
- Headwear may only be worn inside school for religious or health reasons.

Acceptable colours:

- Shirts White, Blue, Black, Grey.
- Trousers and cardigans Black, Navy, Grey
- Shoes Black, Navy, Grey, Brown. Trainers black only.

Unacceptable Dress:

The following items should not be worn to school:

• Tracksuits, leggings, shorts, jeans or any other item of denim clothing, football colours, scarves, items of clothing or footwear with advertising names or logos or any item of clothing which could potentially cause divisions, any form of revealing clothing.

The following items should not be worn to school for health and safety reasons:

• Hoops or dangling earrings, all facial jewellery.
