As part of the Carrick Academy community, we are committed to respecting our environment and each other.

Classroom Expectations

- 1. Arrive for class on time, prepared and ready for work.
- 2. On entering the classroom, remove outdoor wear and sit down quietly.
- 3. Take responsibility for your own behaviour.
- 4. Mobile telephones and personal audio systems must always be switched off in class and in the corridors. At the discretion of the teacher, these may be allowed as a learning aid.
- 5. No eating in class and only water may be drunk at the discretion of the class teacher.

Corridor Movement

- 1. When the bell rings, pupils should go to class following the most direct route, **keeping to the left** in corridors to aid flow of 'traffic'.
- 2. The stairs are one way.

(New building: Office – UP, Business Studies – DOWN

Old building: Boys' toilet – UP, Girls' toilet – DOWN)

3. Entrance to the Old Building is one way.

(ENTRANCE – at Guidance Office

EXIT – at the door beside the S6 common room)

- 4. Any pupil out of class between periods must have permission, carry a pass and follow the most direct route to where they are going.
- 5. Pupils should not enter any class at any time unless supervised by a member of staff or they have permission to do so.
- 6. During morning interval and lunchtime, pupils will have access to the **lower level** of the old building and to the canteen in the new building.
- 7. The administration corridor is out of bounds to pupils at all times unless they need to speak to a member of SMT.

We expect all pupils and staff to follow the school expectations so that we can all enjoy the benefits of working in a pleasant and safe environment.
